

# Working Together Better for the Shannon

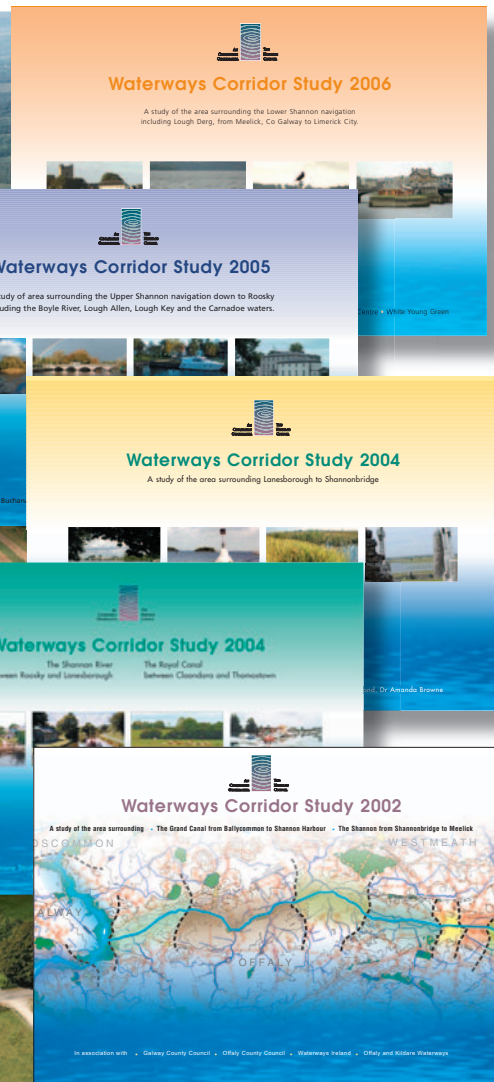
## Corridor Studies: A tool for everyone
