### GLAS TRADITIONAL FARM BUILDINGS GRANT SCHEME TRANCHE 4 2019 TIMELINES (*ESTIMATED*)

<b>Mid/Late January 2019</b>	2019 GLAS Traditional Farm Buildings Grant Scheme announced by Minister of Agriculture, Food & the Marine Heritage Council advertises scheme and invites applications
<b>February 2019</b>	Applicant completes form and submits hard copy application along with other relevant information to Heritage Council by confirmed deadline
<b>Late February 2019</b>	Acknowledgment letters issued
<b>March 2019</b>	Heritage Council screens and assesses all eligible applications using specified criteria Heritage Council notifies all applicants of outcome Information seminar held for shortlisted applicants
<b>April 2019</b>	Grant Offers issued
<b>May/June 2019</b>	Conservation specification submitted for prior agreement Heritage Council carries out initial inspection
<b>June 2019</b>	Grantee ensures bat/bird survey (where required) is carried out
<b>September/October 2019</b>	Grantee submits interim report to Heritage Council Possible Interim Inspection by Heritage Council Heritage Council sends grantee checklist for grant drawdown
<b>October 2019</b>	Grantee completes work and submits final documentation to Heritage Council
<b>October/November 2019</b>	Final Inspection by Heritage Council Snagging to be carried out if needed
<b>November 2019</b>	Heritage Council certifies projects to Department of Agriculture, Food & the Marine for payment
<b>November/December 2019</b>	Grantee paid grant by Department of Agriculture, Food & the Marine
